

1 INT. SCONE CHURCH

PASTOR

It's now time for our cheers, see you soon psalm.

ELIJAH

Whenever I feel all alone, I remember what God or a higher spirit told me. That's we're all made in the image of something holy-e.

PASTOR

Mmm, that psalm felt a little lazy Elijah.

ELIJAH

I had a really busy night Pastor...I was re-watching Season 17 of the Voice.

PASTOR

Alright...well, the Hiking Club is heading out today for their weekly excursion to the nearby state park! You know what they say: hiking a mountain is one of the closest things to seeing God.

AGNES

Who said that Pastor?

PASTOR

I'm sure someone said something to that effect. Well let's hope that the Hiking Club has a great time in the mountains!

fx; just the Pastor clapping

PASTOR

Oh, I thought everyone was going to help me clap for the hiking club.

fx; more clapping

GARFIELD

Why wasn't I invited on this hike? I used to hike all the time back when I was in the war!

PETER

Sorry Garfield, the hiking would be too strenuous for someone of your age.

GARFIELD

You don't know how I old I am you fairy.

MATILDA

This hiking trip sounds expensive, Axl. And you don't even have a job. You quit Dairy Queen because you accidentally shit your pants.

AXL

I thought that my lactose intolerance would stop me from eating ice cream. But those crunchies looked too good...Besides, the church is paying for it.

ALICE

I'm sorry, what did you say?

AXL

The crunchies looked too good--

ALICE

No, the part about SCONE paying for a bunch of sweaty men to hike in the mountains! Are you for real?

AXL

Yeah, I mean I think we got like three hundred dollars

fx; gasps from Alice, Matilda and Pagan Ginger.

PAGAN GINGER

I can't believe I forgot you can get Dairy Queen crunchies on ice cream.

ALICE

Pagan Ginger, that is NOT the reason we just gasped.

MATILDA

Alice and I asked for five thousand dollars for the Feminist Club's trip

to D.C. for the woman's march. We were told there was no way the church had the money for that.

ALICE

And they just GAVE these boys three hundred bucks for wearing boots? No ma'am, this will not stand!

PAGAN GINGER

Well what are we going to do? I like boots, but long black heeled boots, not ones for hiking--

ALICE

Pagan Ginger, please never smoke a whole bowl before church again. We need clear minds to find a way to get back at this church for the clear injustice it has bestowed upon us!

PAGAN GINGER

Alice I smoke a whole bowl to clear my mind.

2 THEME SONG / INT. SCONE RECTORY

LIV

Jonathan, can you do me a favor and go through some of these voicemails that we saved on the phone system?

JONATHAN

Well I'm sure if we saved them, we did it with good reason...

LIV

But the voicemail is full! We have to clear the voicemail.

JONATHAN

I'll just delete all the voicemails we have.

LIV

But what if we have an important voicemail?

JONATHAN

Yeah, I'm sure we have an Oscar winning performance of a voicemail on

this church's phone line.

fx; delete button

LIV

Jonathan, did you just delete all those voicemails?

JONATHAN

I Kon-Maried that Voicemail message box...no one is going to miss junk voicemail.

fx; footsteps

ELIJAH

Liv, can you go through the voicemails and get me the number of that agent that called yesterday who wanted to sign me?

LIV

Uh...

fx; front door

JONATHAN

Oh geez...Alice, Matilda and Pagan Ginger. Here to complain about how we used plastic straws for the coffee yesterday?

ALICE

It seriously wouldn't hurt to use paper straws.

JONATHAN

Once you've put a paper straw in LIQUID, it becomes a mushy ball of paper in three seconds. If I wanted a wet glob of decoupage in a cup, I'd just have Silver take his--

LIV

Jonathan, Matilda is sixteen.

JONATHAN

Trust me, I know Matilda is seeing Chet on the side like mashed potatoes on steak.

PAGAN GINGER

I see Chet more as a triple
cheeseburger than a steak.

ALICE

Liv, we are here to see the Pastor.

ELIJAH

What for? I don't see you in our
appointment book.

MATILDA

It's a girl thing.

ELIJAH

Yikes, you know I can't handle girl
topics. Or guy topics. Actually, I
don't think I can handle any topics.

LIV

Well, let me go see if the Pastor is
in...

fx; footsteps, knocking

PASTOR

Do come in now!

fx; door opens

LIV

Pastor...Alice, Matilda and Pagan
Ginger are here to see you.

PASTOR

What is it concerning? I'm rather busy
Liv.

LIV

You're painting a canvas.

PASTOR

It's a present!

LIV

For your lawyer boyfriend?

PASTOR

Why would you assume it was for my
lawyer boyfriend, whose name by the
way is Desmond?

LIV

Because you're currently painting a picture of yourself...nude, wrapped up in a thin sheet, eating a strawberry and lusciously looking at the viewer.

PASTOR

You might be too smart for this job Liv.

LIV

I wish my paycheck reflected how smart I was.

PASTOR

Well send the girls in. They can maybe tell me if this painting could use a little nip slip.

LIV

Pastor, Matilda is sixteen.

PASTOR

It's the feminist club Liv...they're all mentally forty-five anyway.

3 INT. PASTOR'S OFFICE

PASTOR

Alice, Matilda, Pagan Ginger, what do you ask of me in my office in the rectory on this glorious morning provided by the Mother Earth, Mother Nature and the High Goddess--

MATILDA

Cut it Pastor. We're here to talk money.

PASTOR

Money? I'm sorry, did you loose money in the church? Denise mentioned she found a twenty-dollar bill and then Gladys quickly said she had lost a twenty-dollar bill.

ALICE

No! Pastor you gave three-hundred dollars to the boys club. And you have NEVER, not ONCE funded the Feminist Club!

PASTOR

The boys club? I know we have over seventy-two clubs at this church, but I was not aware we had a boys club...

PAGAN GINGER

Pastor, the Hiking Club *is* the boys club. There are no girls in the Hiking Club.

PASTOR

Are we sure about that? I believe Justine is in the Hiking Club!

MATILDA

Pastor, *Justin* is the one in the Hiking Club.

PASTOR

Ah, well my periods tend to look like 'e's' sometimes...

ALICE

Pastor, how are we supposed to believe that you're a feminist when you'll fund all the penis in this church and not even give one glance at our causes?

PASTOR

First, I'm quite insulted that you believe I'm NOT a feminist. I burned my bras way before it was the 'hot social justice warrior trend'. Granted, I burned a lot of clothes when I lived in NYC. There were bedbugs *everywhere*.

MATILDA

Pastor you didn't want to fund our trip to D.C.

PASTOR

Well we finally have a little money, but certainly not thousands of dollars. The hiking club needed that three hundred dollars to properly enjoy nature.

PAGAN GINGER

Pastor I properly enjoy and worship

nature everyday for free, because a beautiful warrior goddess blessed us with it and really nature is priceless and doesn't need funding.

MATILDA

You know what needs funding. What deserves funding. Our femenists club! We are sick of getting 70 cents of the dollar! Now we're getting zero dollars!

ALICE

THAT IS IT PASTOR! As of right now, the Feminist Club is taking over the rectory!

PASTOR

What? Taking over the rectory--

ALICE

We have weapons Pastor. Like this taser I stole from Garfield.

fx; taser blitz

MATILDA

I took Chet's old bong...it doesn't work for smoking weed but it certainly can be used as a weapon.

fx; bong toot

PAGAN GINGER

And I brought this large sacrificial knife.

fx; knife slice

ALICE

(faux whisper)

Pagan Ginger, I thought we said no real weapons.

PAGAN GINGER

(faux whisper)

Well I'm not going to use it. I'm just going to pretend I'd use it.

PASTOR

Oh my gosh, girls please....

fx; string music

ALICE

Pastor, if you don't leave this
rectory, I will shock you!

ELIJAH

(in the hallway)
Stacey! What an excellent violin solo.

STACEY

Thank you Elijah! I've been practicing
new material!

4 INT. RECTORY

LIV

I'm doing a crossword Jonathan. What's
an eight letter word for lazy bum?

JONATHAN

Oh I LOVE crosswords. Mmm, maybe
'careless'? 'Lethargic'? Oh that's
nine. Lifeless? Passive? Oh that's
seven...

LIV

Oh, I think I have it! It's
'Jonathan.'

fx; silence.

JONATHAN

I swear you're lucky I don't sic the
gay mafia on you.

LIV

You and the gay mafia? I'm sure you
kill people with shady comments about
their clothes. And make their ears
bleed from all there over dramatic
gasps.

JONATHAN

(over dramatic gasp)
You better believe it Miss Department
Outlet Store.

fx; running

PASTOR

Liv, Jonathan we need to leave. Right now.

LIV

Leave? As in stop working? Sounds good to me...

ALICE

No, leave as in LEAVE the rectory.

JONATHAN

Alice...is that a taser?

ALICE

The Feminist Club is taking over the rectory.

ELIJAH

Get off of me...please, get off of me.

PAGAN GINGER

Well next time a girl asks you to do something maybe you won't be a pig man!

ELIJAH

I hope a girl never asks me to do anything.

fx; rectory door.

MATILDA

Alright, out with the staff.

JONATHAN

Well what about Carol Ann?

PAGAN GINGER

Carol Ann is our club advisor.

LIV

Wait, I'm a true feminist. I insult every man I know. Why am I not an advisor?

ALICE

Well you can be an advisor now. Right after we slam the door on Pastor, Elijah and Jonathan.

PASTOR
Girls, please don't do this-

fx; slam.

PAGAN GINGER
I'm calling the rest of the club right now! We're taking over this rectory!

LIV
Well, now that you kicked Pastor, Elijah and Jonathan out of the rectory by brute force, my first piece of advice, as your advisor, is to let them back in.

ALICE
Liv, they *refuse* to give the Feminist Club a *dime*. Yet the boys get three hundred bucks to play Huckleberry Finn in the mountains?

LIV
Do you really think that hiking trip is fun for any of the SCONE boys?

5 INT. MOUNTAINS

PETER
What a great first day of hiking! I'm very proud of the hiking trip

fx; 'huzzah'

PETER
I'm thinking we can go around the campfire and share some stories. Who wants to go first?

BENNI
Well I have a really fun story about the church hall.

JUSTIN
Oh cool dude. Let's hear it.

BENNI
Well one time, after mass there was a doughnuts and coffee event.

PETER

Ah, okay.

BENNI

And after the event was over, there were FIVE leftover donuts.

fx; silence

JUSTIN

Was that the story?

BENNI

Can you believe it? Five donuts? I was set for the week all because nobody wanted five donuts.

fx; silence

PETER

Does anyone else have a good story?

6 INT. SCONE RECTORY

ALICE

Alright, we have everyone from the feminist club assembled here in the rectory. Does everyone know their tasks?

PAGAN GINGER

Denise's Niece Elise and I checked the security. It's all locked up.

ELISE

It's just Elise...and yeah, nobody's getting in here.

CAROL ANN

Oh and I made the snacks!

JUSTINE

Wait...are we sure Carol Ann is like on our side?

CAROL ANN

What do you mean Justine?

JUSTINE

Well like you're part of the staff. And we kicked the staff out of the

rectory and onto the curb.

CAROL ANN

Oh sweetie...*girls* come before *the man*! I remember one time when I was kidnapped into a sex cult, I grabbed a knife and stabbed the cult leader in the face--

ALICE

Carol Ann what kind of snacks did you make?

CAROL ANN

I made some fruit salad but only with feminine fruit. Like strawberries and grapes.

ELISE

How are grapes a 'feminine fruit'.

CAROL ANN

Because grapes look like ovum.

MATILDA

Welp, now I lost my appetite.

JANICE

Alice, I already did my part!

ALICE

Oh, you made sure to fill a tub with fresh water in case they decided to turn off the water?

JANICE

Nope, I put some charms on the house.

ALICE

That wasn't your job Janice.

JANICE

Of course it was, I'm the only Hogwarts-approved witch in the Feminist Club!

ALICE

Jesus, why did I invite Janice into the Feminist Club?

LIV

Girls, let me say this again: I think this is a bad idea.

ALICE

Noted. Now let's all look around the office for money.

JANICE

I have a charm for that too!

ALICE

I'm sure you do.

7 EXT. SCONE RECTORY

ELIJAH

Pastor, it's been an hour. Should we call the police?

PASTOR

Of course not! The police would shoot these girls dead and blow up the rectory!

ELIJAH

The sad thing is I don't know if you're exaggerating or not.

JONATHAN

You guys, we need to negotiate with the girls.

PASTOR

Well how do we do that?

JONATHAN

Actually, I have the PERFECT tool for negotiation.

fx: swipe

PASTOR

Jonathan, you own a megaphone?

JONATHAN

I bought it when I tried out for my college's cheerleading team!

ELIJAH

I didn't know you were a cheerleader.

JONATHAN

Oh, I'm not. I ended sleeping through the auditions. But I bought some cute outfits.

PASTOR

(in the megaphone)

coughs. Feminist Club...I understand your demands. Perhaps there is a way for SCONE to fund you and your plans?

MATILDA

(in the distance)

How so?

PASTOR

(in the megaphone)

I will give you guys twenty dollars...you can split a fun t-shirt or maybe all go to Applebees and get a couple half priced appetizers?

MATILDA

(in the distance)

Womuen's rights won't be solved by clothes and shitty frozen food!

PASTOR

Well, I tried.

ELIJAH

Let me try.

ELIJAH

(in the megaphone)

Girls, maybe we can get you some free intern hours for school? Of course, you'd have to pay the school for the intern credits...

MATILDA

(in the distance)

I'd rather take the bulk processed frozen apps than that Elijah!

JONATHAN

Gosh the two of you are worse negotiators than Oprah's dietitian. Give me my megaphone

JONATHAN

(in the megaphone)

Listen sweeties...this is going to end in two ways: badly or with you guys getting something out of this. So what do you want? New purses? A date with boys? An expensive premium Panera Bread salad?

MATILDA

(in the distance)

Just for that comment, we're truly going to dig our heels in!

JONATHAN

(in the megaphone)

Oh you want new heels?

8 EXT. MOUNTAINS

fx; bonfire crackling, cough of silence.

MARIO

Well I guess I have a story.

PETER

Please Mario, do share.

MARIO

I was fixing an appliance when I turn around and a naked woman was at the doorway. I said, 'mamma mia, why are you sharing your beef veal with me' and she said 'I want your marinara sauce on me'.

COMMUNIST DEREK

Oh wow, this is a hot story.

PETER

I'm more of a meat guy than a fish guy myself. Please continue Mario.

MARIO

And then I said, 'well I usually disappoint the women. I am, as what you say in English, a 'premature finisher'.

fx; awkward silence.

AXL

God I'd rather be in school. And by be
in school I mean suspended from school
and at home.

9 EXT. SCONE RECTORY

PASTOR

Negotiations failed...what are we
going to do?

fx; footsteps

MARCY

I was over in the church practicing my
new song, 'Kisses and Candy'. I heard
there was a situation and figured I'd
come help you guys.

ELIJAH

Well we could lob Marcy at them.

JONATHAN

Lob her like the destructive bomb she
is.

PASTOR

Marcy, can you go in the rectory and
calm down the Feminist Club?

MARCY

Absolutely. I was the one who
negotiated Marcy Playground's demands
on our 2003 tour.

JONATHAN

I bet that went well since everyone
remembers the band Marcy Playground.

MARCY

Originally they wanted to put us in
Motel 6...I got them convinced to move
us to the Holiday Inn.

ELIJAH

Is that even an upgrade? Sounds like a
horizontal promotion to me.

MARCY

I'll take care of these girls the way
I took care of my agent.

fx; footsteps

ELIJAH

Oh shoot, I am looking for a new agent. Should I ask Marcy for her agent's contact?

JONATHAN

Marcy's agent is probably Marcy herself.

fx; footsteps

10 INT. SCONE RECTORY

ALICE

Has anyone found anything worth of value?

ELISE

Elijah's great-grandmother's golden stapler...but I don't think it's real gold.

CAROL ANN

I found the smoke machine. We paid some money for that.

JUSTINE

I found some weed. But the weed was in my pocket.

PAGAN GINGER

Girl, let's smoke in the name of women's right.

ALICE

None of this is valuable! I'm going crazy...

fx; door opens

MARCY

Hello girls, it's the church celebrity: Marcy, here to help end this strife.

ALICE

Well now I'm guaranteed going crazy.

CAROL ANN
How did Marcy get in here?

MATILDA
Marcy, we're not giving up until we
have money.

MARCY
I wasn't told what I could negotiate.
But since this place makes less money
than our official Marcy Playgounrd
waterbottle line, I assume there's not
much money around here.

JUSTINE
Weird, I'm surprised Pastor and Elijah
are breaking the rules of torture set
by the Geneva Convention.

ALICE
Well since you're useless Marcy,
you'll be our *hostage*.

LIV
Don't you think that having a hostage
is taking this a bit too far?

ALICE
Carol Ann, tie up Marcy with some of
that rope we have left over from the
tug-of-war game at La Carnival.

CAROL ANN
Gladly!

MARCY
I haven't been a hostage since in the
music video we did for the fourth
single off our third album. What a
treat, working with Jaxques Van Jones.

CAROL ANN
I'm sorry Marcy, I'm not listening.
Did any of this actually happen?

MARCY
Of course it did, I'm a star.

CAROL ANN
Oh, that reminds me of the time I
watched the stars with the lead singer

of Pearl Jam. We had both gotten Grand Slams at Denny's --.

11 EXT. SCONE RECTORY

PASTOR

Do you think Marcy convinced them to give up the rectory?

JONATHAN

Well all Marcy would have to do would be to sing. That would get the girls running.

ELIJAH

It's a shame that Marcy is still the best voice in the choir...

fx; footsteps

CHET

I came as fast as I could.

JONATHAN

Well with your short, thick stature that must have taken you an hour.

PASTOR

Chet, what are you doing here?

CHET

I'm here to help. I...really like Matilda. Maybe I can make a plea with her.

JONATHAN

That means they're snogging right?

ELIJAH

Well Chet, here's the megaphone. Try your best.

CHET

(in the megaphone)

Matilda, I think you're so special and I really like you, I almost lo...lo....you know what I mean. But if you spend the rest of your life in this rectory...I'll never get the chance to lo...lo...

ELIJAH

To login to a joint email account?

PASTOR

I may not be a teenage girl, but back when I was a teenage girl in Zimbabwe, I would have swooned for a guy who made a plea like Chet.

MATILDA

(yelling)

Sorry Chet, I think you're cute but I have to stand up for women's rights!

CHET

(in the microphone)

You know what, I respect it. And I will wait for you.

ELIJAH

What a reverse gender experience, usually girls are the ones waiting on boys.

JONATHAN

Oh I've seen most of the Feminist Club Elijah, ain't no boys waiting around on them hoes.

fx; running steps

GARFIELD

James and I came as soon as we heard the church was under attack.

JAMES

AS you know we WE WERE ONCE UNDER ATTACK in the WAR!

PASTOR

Well the church is fine. It's the rectory that's under attack. And even then it's not really under attack, it's more of a siege situation

JAMES

A SIEGE SITUATION! JIMMINY CRICKET GARFIELD, the Communist witches have taken over our rectory, we must act immediately for the SAKE of our FREEDOM!

GARFIELD

James, what do we do?

JAMES

Pastor, do we have access to planes?

PASTOR

No.

JAMES

What about guns?

PASTOR

Definitely not.

JAMES

What about Agent Orange?

PASTOR

Agent Orange? You mean the toxic material they dropped over the forests? We certainly don't have that nor condone Agent Orange James!

GARFIELD

Back in my hayday, I was an undercover operative in Korea named Agent Orange. They called me Agent Orange because I had a frizzy orange wig and used to sing for the boys down at the makeshift bar--

ELIJAH

Well where's that award-winning voice you had while being undercover? Because Garfield you're very pitchy lately in the choir...

JAMES

Pastor I will see to it that we handle a strike mission on these overbearing women.

fx; footsteps

JONATHAN

I'm sorry, I was texting a hunk, did the History Channel go to commercial?

fx; footsteps

CHARLENE

Good day everyone, why are we all outside the former bakery that we've converted into a rectory?

PASTOR

The feminist club has taken over the rectory and are threatening us.

CHARLENE

OMG, are they threatening my foster plants?

ELIJAH

No, I don't think they were worried about the part-time bookkeeper--

CHARLENE

I need to immediately get home at once and check in on my daisies!

fx; running footsteps

ELIJAH

I...even I don't get where that anxiety came from. And I'm more anxious than a room of anxious teenagers at a school dance.

12 INT. SCONE RECTORY

MARCY

...after that, it was just downhill from there. John Wozniak and I just got into so many fights over the band. It just spread through the whole group. He'd want to eat at Chipotle, I wanted Panera Bread because of all my points. John Wozniak wanted to partner with Dove Chocolates, I wanted Marcy Playground to partner with the true superior chocolate, Hersey's. That's just the beginning of how I got kicked out-- I mean left of my own accord.

MATILDA

Alice, the girls are losing morale. Marcy's stories are making us go mad.

ALICE

Well then we really only have one

choice do we?

13 EXT. SCENE RECTORY

PASTOR

The doors to the rectory are opening!

ELIJAH

Are they coming out?

fx; door rectory

ALICE

You can take back Marcy, she's the worst hostage ever!

MARCY

Ow, you were supposed to free me from this rope and *then* toss me out the door.

fx; door slams

JONATHAN

So...they just gave Marcy back to us. Was this maybe the shortest hostage situation ever?

14 INT. SCENE TUNNEL

GARFIELD

James, it was a good idea to use Carol Ann's underground tunnel. We'll be inside the rectory in no time.

JAMES

When we get there, use this large plastic bat I found in the pile of toy donations for kids.

GARFIELD

Oh, now that's a nice bat.

JAMES

Dang it, I can't see down in this rectory basement. Why is this place built like some haunted castle? It reminds me of the war!

GARFIELD

I hope this isn't it for me, I'm too

young to die!

JAMES

If I didn't die in the jungles of the Congo, then I won't die here.

GARFIELD

I thought you were in the Vietnam War? Why were you in the Congos?

JAMES

I was in the congo cause it was a poorly planned vacation from a travel agent who I never worked with again.

GARFIELD

WoAH

fx; falls

JAMES

OH NO GARFIELD ARE YOU OKAY?

GARFIELD

MAN DOWN MAN DOWN I AM NOT OKAY

JAMES

WHAT ATTACKED YOU FELLOW TROUPE MEMBER

GARFIELD

It's soft and tangly, like a fabric!

JAMES

Curse these fabrics, WOAH!

fx; falls

JAMES

Garfield, I've fallen too!

GARFIELD

Curses, this is it for us ol' friend. We've been had. The enemy has got us with silk.

JAMES/GARFIELD

Noooooooooooooooooo!

15 INT. RECTORY

PAGAN GINGER

Um, Alice. I think I can hear James and Garfield in the basement...they might have used the tunnel. Should I just lock the door so they can't get in?

ALICE

Yes Pagan Ginger.

PAGAN GINGER

Alrighty.

fx; door locks

LIV

Alice, don't you think this has gone far enough? You turned over your hostage, there's no leverage and you guys aren't going to be able to stay in this rectory forever!

ALICE

Liv, just admit that you side with the man! The camping boys just get all the money and the girls can just suffer!

LIV

Well come now Alice, do you really think the boys are having fun?

16 EXT. MOUNTAINS

fx; silence and crackling fire

PETER

Well, that was a great twenty-five minute story from Socialist Dave about Socialism and a twenty-five minute response about Communism from Communist Derek.

SOCIALIST DAVE

Thank you, I thought it was quite riveting material.

COMMUNIST DEREK

Down with the proletariat scum!

SOCIALIST DAVE

Hiking truly is a bourgeoisie activity though, don't you think?

fx; communist and socialist fight in the background

PETER

Justin, do you have a story to share?

JUSTIN

No man, I'm just rubbing this THC lotion and listening man.

PETER

Axl, what about you?

AXL

Yeah, my story is why the hell did I come on this hiking trip.

COMMUNIST DEREK

Dave, I respect you as my equal. But comrade, you're clearly off your meds to suggest that a system devoid of control would be fine with limited government power.

SOCIALIST DAVE

Well Communist Derek, socialism hasn't been tried in it's true form. Unlike Russia's Communist experiment...

COMMUNIST DEREK

The soviet union WAS NOT a communist society, it was an absolute tyranny--

PETER

We have a long day, why don't we turn in?

SOCIALIST DAVE

Yes Peter, after I school Communist Derek on some tenants of socialism.

AXL

It's not a camping trip unless we talk about tenants of government systems.

17 EXT. RECTORY

PASTOR

Well, I just got a text from James that says 'mission aborted.' I'm going to say that James and Garfield's strike mission was a failure.

ELIJAH

What are we going to do Pastor? I have to write an original psalm for mass.

PASTOR

We have six days till mass. I imagine you'll have it done by then.

ELIJAH

Well if these keeps up, I'll only have a sloppy psalm at best!
