

1 TCLEAR INT. CONFERENCE ROOM

fx; Pure audio chaos

CHET / AXL / ELIJAH / HONEY / SAMANTHA
I didn't do this, I couldn't have /
Dude we are totally being framed right
now / I don't like confronting people,
but I feel like we're about to
confront people / We all need to alm
down with a lavender creme latte. /
Guys, I think I might make out with
this boy, aren't I random?

PASTOR
Alright, enough everyone! We're going
to be here all night if we continue
like this!

SAMANTHA
That's *exactly* what I told the last
guy I hooked up with.

JONATHAN
Samantha, that's my joke!

SAMANTHA
Sorry Jonathan! I've heard that we're
actually quite similar...

JONATHAN
Yah, except I'm actually kind of a
slut and you're definitely not a slut
at all.

PASTOR
We are here to find the truth. Because
this is the fourth time in SCONE
history that this has happened and
it's getting ridiculous...

CHET
I think it's ridiculous that I'm being
accused of this crime.

ELIJAH
Chet, the evidence is pretty
overwhelming. It's more overwhelming
than how overwhelmed I was when I met
Celine Dion's backup singer.

JONATHAN

I remember that, you literally cried to her and said 'Because You Loved Me' changed your life.

CHET

Listen. I'm like that guy from Making a Murderer. Is he a good person? No. Does he commit casual crime? Yes. But it doesn't mean I did *this* crime.

fx; knock at the door

PASTOR

Ah, I think that might be your parents. Carol Ann, you may enter.

CAROL ANN

Pastor, the teens' parents are here. Shall I have them come to this conference room.

PASTOR

Well of course Carol Ann, where else are they going to go?

CAROL ANN

Well the last time I brought guests immediately into a room without asking you, you told me that I 'invaded the space with guests who had you were yet to be properly ready for.'

PASTOR

Well that's because you traipsed into my office with my mother.

CAROL ANN

But Pastor, you and your mother had lunch plans.

PASTOR

I know, but I was going to make my mom wait for twenty minutes and then cancel lunch.

CAROL ANN

Well back in my day, daughters and mothers had a wonderful time at lunch.

JONATHAN

You have a daughter?

CAROL ANN

Oh yes, I have four children: the spunky Cecelia, sweet Vixy, charming Louis and my gay son Chester.

JONATHAN

You have a gay son?! Why have you never set us up! Old people love setting younger people up!

ELIJAH

Carol Ann, I never knew you had kids!

CAROL ANN

I talk about them all the time!

fx; swipe

CAROL ANN

I just got off the phone with my son Louis...he got a promotion and he's moving to Chicago!

ELIJAH

Oh that reminds me, the SCONE theater club wants to do Chicago the musical but I've never seen it because I've heard it's sinful. Your thoughts Carol Ann?

fx; swipe

CAROL ANN

Jonathan, could you handle this paperwork? I don't want to be late for my lunch with my daughter Cecelia...

JONATHAN

You lost me at the phrase 'could you', but then you had me at the word 'handle' and then totally lost me at the word 'paperwork'.

fx; swipe

CAROL ANN

Pastor, do we have any stamps? I want to send this picture of my four

children and my husband Patrick and I,
to a couple people as a Christmas
Card....

PASTOR

Carol Ann are you using *office
supplies as personal supplies?*

CAROL ANN

Well I just need a couple more stamps,
I under-ordered at the post office...

PASTOR

I cannot believe that someone we pay
to be here--

CAROL ANN

Oh I'm a volunteer, I'm not paid.

PASTOR

--someone who we give so much for--

CAROL ANN

I guess so--

PASTOR

Someone who honestly needs to work
harder and smarter!

CAROL ANN

A bit of a barbed criticism, but
understandable...

PASTOR

--wants to steal stamps from the
church? Carol Ann...this is
unspeakable.

CAROL ANN

You're right, I'll take the bus back
to the post office and buy three
stamps.

fx; swipe

JONATHAN

Okay but I'm shocked Carol Ann that
you have a gay son and didn't tell me?

CAROL ANN

Well he's like forty Jonathan.

JONATHAN

So?

CAROL ANN

And he's married.

JONATHAN

So?

CAROL ANN

And he lives in Charleston.

JONATHAN

So?

CAROL ANN

Well...my bad then.

PASTOR

Carol Ann please stop gabbing about your kids and grab these teenager's parents.

CAROL ANN

On it!

fx; door closes, footsteps

CHET

Listen, my mother supports me unconditionally. I really doubt you're going to get her to...

fx; door opens

CHET'S MOTHER

CHET What in the world did you do this time? Drop cockroaches in the church sink? Super glue Elijah's keyboard keys? You jerk, I can't believe I'm getting another call about the shit you pulled.

CHET

Thanks for believing me mom.

CHET'S MOTHER

Oh I do believe you. I believe you're a juvenile delinquent and I believe you'll end up in jail or dead! This is all you're fathers fault. If he was

around more...

PASTOR

Chet's mom, we love and support Chet.
We don't call him a juvenile
delinquent.

ELIJAH

Yeah, we call him a troublesome
teenager. It's less judgemental. After
all--

PASTOR / ELIJAH / CHET / AXL / SAMANTHA /
HONEY

No judgement.

HONEY'S MOM

As Honey's mother, I doubt my daughter
was involved. She's a self made
businesswoman.

JONATHAN

So I can make homemade vodka in my
house and suddenly be a self made
businesswoman? Okay.

HONEY

Mom, I promise it wasn't me.

AXL'S DAD

What exactly happened? Is Axl in
trouble? Since I'm Axl's Father, I am
responsible for his growth and
development.

AXL

I have a growth that needs developing.

AXL'S DAD

HA! Alright that was funny...but cut
it out.

SAMANTHA'S DAD

I agree with Honey's mom. My daughter
Samantha is a great child.

SAMANTHA

Thanks dad, I know it's hard raising a
slut.

MATILDA'S MOM
And I raise Matilda.

MATILDA
Mom, I didn't do anything. You know it wasn't me, right?

MATILDA'S MOM
Even if it was, I'm sure you had a good reason.

CHET'S MOTHER
Well what exactly happened?

PASTOR
Here's the crime: someone broke the stained glass window. Again.

ELIJAH
And we're going to find out who did it.

JONATHAN
Truly a gripping crime.

2 INT. THEME SONG

3 INT. CONFERENCE ROOM

AXL'S DAD
Doesn't the stained glass window break a lot? Maybe it says more about the quality of the stained glass window than who is breaking it.

JONATHAN
Gurl, it's GLASS. That shit breaks quicker than my diet when I go to a bakery.

ELIJAH
We realize that we have no disciplinary skills.

PASTOR
Which is why we called in Liv.

LIV
Hi everyone.

JONATHAN

You've been eerily silent.

LIV

Oh I'm just here to watch this shit-show play out.

HONEY'S MOM

Well, like my daughter Honey, I like to learn things by talking them through. So tell me what happened.

HONEY

No worries Mom!

HONEY'S MOM

Thanks daughter.

JONATHAN

We get it, you're Honey's Mom!

HONEY'S MOM

Honey's Mom, that's me!

HONEY

Well it all started earlier tonight when we were meeting at teen night...

fx; harpsichord

4 FLASHBACK SEQUENCE:

5 INT. CHURCH HALL

MATILDA

Welcome to SCONE Teen Night everyone. I'm Matilda, president of the teen club.

CHET

Matilda, it's like the same people here every month. We know you're Matilda.

MATILDA

I'm just going through Teen Night protocol. Let's call attendance. Vice President Honey?

HONEY

Here! And I brought homemade gluten-

free organic, cruelty-free, peanut-free, non-crunchy peanut butter brittle.

AXL

How can peanut butter brittle be peanut-free and non-crunchy?

HONEY

It's made with fake nuts.

CHET

Don't worry, my nuts are real.

MATILDA

Speaking of jack asses... is our Treasurer Chet here?

CHET

Me and the twenty dollar budget are here.

MATILDA

And our secretary, Samantha?

SAMANTHA

Mmm, the *dirty, filthy, nasty* secretary reporting for hot action duty.

MATILDA

And that leaves our sergeant at arms, Axl.

AXL

The only job I want: one that has to do with my arms.

MATILDA

You'll notice that our teen night and teen club advisor is not here tonight. Garfield had a war reenactment and told me 'I need to work on my battle skills, not babysit a bunch of teen hussys'

CHET

That sounds like Garfield alright. What a legend.

MATILDA

So replacing Garfield is our auxiliary advisors: Elijah and Marcy.

AXL

(sarcasm)

We're blessed that we get two advisors...especially two cool people.

ELIJAH

Thank you for having Marcy and I.

MARCY

Luckily I had a cleared schedule and could be here tonight.

CHET

Your whole schedule is clear I bet.

SAMANTHA

Was there no karaoke bar that needed help tonight Marcy?

MARCY

Karaoke? Ha! I'd rather have dinner with Tori Amos again. Let's just say her dinner conversation practically *crucified* me...she really is a *raisin girl*...dry and flavorless. Anyway, I don't do karaoke. I'm a professional singer, not a wannabe half tone-deaf local aspirant who covers one-hit wonders from the 80s and 90s.

AXL

Are you talking about yourself when you say a 'wannabe half tone-deaf local aspirant?'

MARCY

No, I'm talking about karaoke vultures.

CHET

Damn Marcy, don't be talking smack on your own species.

ELIJAH

Well I know it's movie night, so I brought a suggestion. It's a documentary called "My Fake Self:

Social Media In the Modern Age, A story of One Woman's fight against the online platforms which tried to deny her identity; an overlook at the increasing digital landscape."

MATILDA / EVERYONE ELSE
That sounds thrilling! / That sounds terrible.

MARCY
No worries teens, I brought a great movie. It's a bootleg copy of a documentary that never made it to the big screen. It's a documentary about Marcy Playground--

fx; multiple moans

AXL
Why didn't it air?

MARCY
Well there were some problems between the film makers and the band.

HONEY
And by problems with the band you mean you?

MARCY
Well I'm sorry but I will not stand by and let some independent layperson with a hogwash camera ruin the image I have in mind.

SAMANTHA
But like, maybe I'm just a dumb whore but like aren't you not supposed to have control over a documentary that's being made of you?

MARCY
Samantha, I won't just let art happen around me without my input.

ELIJAH
We've seen you with the Poetry Club...you definitely provide input.

MATILDA

Well no offense Marcy but I don't think anyone wants to watch a documentary about Marcy Playground. Especially a bootleg version.

MARCY

Close your eyes and listen to the music.

AXL

Well last time we watched a movie that Chet and I wanted.

HONEY

How could we forget that boring superhero movie from last time.

SAMANTHA

Oh I didn't forget those buns and abs of steel.

MATILDA

I was thinking we could watch "Miss Sanchez" it's about a young college professor who falls in love with one of her students.

ELIJAH

(a little pitchy)

Well that sounds a little too risky, don't you think?

AXL

Are there gratuitous and unnecessary sex scenes?

MATILDA

Oh absolutely.

ELIJAH

Really? I don't think that's a good idea for a church teen club.

SAMANTHA

No judgement Elijah, you can't censor art.

CHET

I mean Elijah, you could censor art. But then you'd be no better than

Marcy.

ELIJAH

Oh my gosh, that's a serious accusation.

MARCY

An accusation I'm happy to be accused of.

ELIJAH

Well why don't you start the movie and I'll go get gluten-free organic, cruelty-free, free-trade, vegan crackers and some gluten-free organic, cruelty-free, free-trade, cow-free, dairy-free nut-free vegan cheese spread.

fx; footsteps

MARCY

Alright, I'll put the movie in. When I die, please remember all the work I did.

CHET

Marcy, I've seen you work. You can't even legally call what you do work.

SAMANTHA

Hey Matilda, do you want to see the dress I got for the Sadie Hawkins Dance?

MATILDA

Sure...wait, that's your dress? This dress pictured on your cell phone device?

SAMANTHA

I got it because it's extremely revealing.

MATILDA

Samantha, that's the dress I got!

SAMANTHA

Why would you buy my dress Matilda, you're not a slut?

MATILDA

Are YOU, a WOMAN, telling me, a WOMAN, what I can not do as a WOMAN?

CHET

Oh geez, Matilda does not like it when she, as a woman, is told what to do.

SAMANTHA

You're not even going to look good in that dress Matilda, you're not a slut.

MATILDA

I've been with more guys than--

6 INT. CONFERENCE ROOM

Swipe and transition sound

MATILDA

Alright, we can cut out some of that scene, right Pastor?

PASTOR

I suppose we can.

MATILDA'S MOM

What does 'been with more guys' mean?

MATILDA

Nothing mom, it's youth slang.

CHET

So Marcy was taking forever to put the movie in. Because according to Marcy she's 'never had to put in a DVD in before'

MARCY

In my defense, I was busy recording albums. Not watching straight to VHS movies.

HONEY

But Marcy, the movie was on Natflux. It wasn't like we had to put in a DVD.

MARCY

How dare you, I struggled with that television for twenty minutes. I haven't struggled that long since I

did a duet with Dave Grohl's less talented cousin at the pre-grammys pre-grammy party.

ELIJAH

Meanwhile, I was taking a quick break.

PASTOR

I thought you went to get inclusive and diverse cracker and cheese options?

ELIJAH

All that sex talk kind of freaked me out.

HONEY

So with Elijah gone, and Marcy distracted, things just fell into chaos.

HONEY'S MOM

My daughter is really good at chaos.

AXL

I'd agree with that Honey's Mom.

MATILDA

All you need to know is that Samantha and I couldn't have broken the stained glass window.

SAMANTHA

Yeah, we were fighting because we bought the same dress for the Sadie Hawkins Dance.

MARCY

Well I know it wasn't me.

CHET

Are we sure about that? You always love stirring the pot.

MARCY

When have I done that?

CHET / AXL / ELIJAH / HONEY / SAMANTHA

The time when you made the witches and the nerd club fight in the parking lot? / When you gave us vodka at the

bingo event / Honestly just you
singing is stirring the pot / The time
at the softball game when you like
ruined everything. / You're always
insulting your own step-granddaughter.

MARCY

Alright I get it. But like I said, I
have an alibi. I was listening to some
hot new demos while the rest of you
were watching the movie.

PASTOR

So instead of watching the kids, you
put on some headphones and listened to
some poorly made alternative demos.

fx; swipe

7 INT. CHURCH HALL

Marcy is humming and listening to alternative music.

MARCY

Mmmhm, *I want fondling and fondue...*
no that doesn't work.

8 INT. CONFERENCE ROOM

ELIJAH

Well I have evidence that puts Chet
and Axl at the scene of the crime. I
was coming back from grabbing those
cheese and crackers when I heard the
sound of what seemed like Marcy
singing.

PASTOR

So when you ran to the sound of
Marcy's vocals, what did you find?

ELIJAH

I found a broken stained glass window!
And I also found Chet and Axl standing
over the broken glass!

fx; mumble mumble gasp mumble mutter gasp in the background

CHET

Alright so Axl and I were at the scene
of the crime. But that's not because

we *committed* the crime.

CHET'S MOTHER

Chet, you know I love you. But you are a troublesome teen with a penchant for crime and deviance.

CHET

Geez Mom, what are you? A cop?

CHET'S MOTHER

Honey you know I'm a police Sergeant. Sergeant Chet's Mother...

ELIJAH

Well that explains why Chet hasn't gotten in trouble with the police.

CHET

I'm allowed ten more mistakes. And then that's it.

AXL

Elijah, Pastor...don't Chet and I get a chance to explain what happened? Like can't we share our perspective?

ELIJAH

We don't need your perspective, we have you at the crime scene.

LIV

I think it's only fair that Chet and Axl state their case.

PASTOR

What is this? The court of law?

LIV

Well in the theme of 'no judgement', we shouldn't cast judgement until we have heard all the stories and examined all the facts.

PASTOR

UGH fine I guess we will follow protocol.

JONATHAN

We don't have protocol.

ELIJAH

Listen it's late and I can't be up all night. I have the Regional District Multi-Fatih Singing Competition Semifinals...

MARCY

We get it, you do music. You don't have to talk about being an amateur wannabe musician every two minutes.

fx; crickets

CHET

SO ANYWAY, the girls were arguing so Axl and I decided that we were just going to go take a walk.

PASTOR

Probably so you could get up to some deviance.

AXL

Actually no, we were talking about our romantic relationships.

fx; swipe

9 INT. CHURCH HALL

CHET

It's just hard cause I really respect and love Matilda. And I want to be honest, but I don't want to hurt her.

AXL

Yeah.

CHET

Like I go back and forth. It's just a lost cause we're teenagers and we should just like have fun and not worry about big problems.

AXL

Yeah.

CHET

Do you think I should just take to her and see what happens? Just be honest and all that?

AXL

Yeah.

CHET

Thanks man, you're great to talk to about these kind of issues.

fx; breaking glass

AXL

What was that?

CHET

It sounds like something broke...which is what we normally do.

AXL

Let's check it out.

fx; footsteps

CHET

Wow, someone destroyed the stained glass window...

AXL

But that's what we do.

fx; footsteps

ELIJAH

Oh my *lordddd*. Wait a minute, I can't be singing. I have to save my vocals for the

ELIJAH / CHET / AXL

Regional District Multi-Fatih Singing Competition Semifinals.

ELIJAH

Boys, how could you break this window?

CHET

Elijah, we didn't do this! We came here because we heard the sound.

ELIJAH

Knowing your past Chet, I highly doubt you're innocent here. I'm calling the Pastor and all your parents.

fx; swipe

10 INT. CONFERENCE ROOM

PASTOR

Well we probably need some more evidence before we convict Chet and Axl of this crime.

LIV

Exactly, do we have fingerprints, camera footage, eyewitnesses?

MARCY

I *did* witness some things tonight.

ELIJAH

Really? Marcy, what did you see?

MARCY

Well I saw that this producer sent me a really poorly made track. The bass was just heinous.

PASTOR

So you didn't witness anything relating to the crime?

MARCY

I think a poorly made music demo is a crime!

LIV

Pastor, we cannot convict these two based on the evidence alone.

PASTOR

You're right, we can't take this to SCONE Court.

fx; SCONE Court audio gag

LIV

SCONE COURT? Since when did we have a court?

ELIJAH

Oh Liv, we rarely intervene with the judges of SCONE Court.

fx; SCONE Court audio gag

ELIJAH

The court has only ever been in session one time over a parking violation.

CHET

I thought the SCONE Court was a myth.

fx; SCONE Court audio gag

PASTOR

Oh it's real...and so are there decisions.

fx; string music

ELIJAH

Sorry, that's my ringtone when child violin prodigy Annabelle sends me a text.

AXL'S DAD

Alright, can I just pay for this window? How much did the stained glass window cost?

PASTOR

Axl's dad, we are here for something *more* than just a check. Although you can make that check out to the Society of the Children of the Natural Earth...

ELIJAH

We have to talk about consequences.

SAMANTHA

Well maybe the consequence should be that Matilda can't wear MY dress at the Sadie Hawkins dance!

MATILDA

How is that a consequence for Chet and Axl?

SAMANTHA

Well you're dating Chet, so therefore you're as guilty as him.

MATILDA'S MOM

Matilda, you have a boyfriend?

MATILDA

No, I have a partner mom. You know I don't do traditional romantic norms.

CHET

I don't care what she calls me, I'm just happy to be here.

ELIJAH

Is that what you said before you blew up the window?

fx; commotion at the door

CAROL ANN

I made some hot tea...does anyone want some?

HONEY

Is it probiotic green tea with honey?

CAROL ANN

No, it's just English Breakfast...actually it's a cheap knock off called English Snack.

HONEY

I'm good then.

ELIJAH

The only tea I want is honesty.

fx; some groans

CAROL ANN

Also, Gladys, Agnes and Pagan Ginger are here.

PASTOR

Why?

CAROL ANN

Apparently they witnessed the event?

ELIJAH

Why?

CAROL ANN

I guess they were praying in the church?

JONATHAN
SURE they were.

PASTOR
Well if we have witnesses to the
crime, bring them in.

CAROL ANN
I'll go get them.

MARCY
Please hurry Carol Ann, we don't have
time for a geriatric shuffle to the
door...

fx; footsteps

CHET
Well this is great, they'll confirm
we're not the ones who did it.

CHET'S MOTHER
Chet, look into your mother's eyes and
tell me you didn't do this.

CHET
Mom, I'm staring at you and telling
you that I didn't break the window.

CHET'S MOTHER
Wow, that's so powerful. I think I
believe him.

ELIJAH
Just like the time when Chet flooded
the basement and said it wasn't him?

PASTOR
Well since Chet and Axl probably did
this, let's talk about a just
punishment.

AXL
Pastor, there are witnesses.

ELIJAH
Yeah, but that doesn't mean we can't
start throwing ideas out there.

PASTOR
I'm thinking a hundred service hours

each.

CHET

Great, that means I'll have seven hundred and twenty four service hours to complete now.

ELIJAH

I think the two should have to attend some kind of prison tryouts.

LIV

You mean like scared straight?

JONATHAN

I've only been ever scared more gay if anything.

LIV

Why are you even here?

JONATHAN

My date canceled on me and this was the best thing I could do with my Friday night.

LIV

Sounds like my Friday night.

fx; door knocks

CAROL ANN

Agnes, Gladys and Pagan Ginger are here to see you.

PASTOR

Please, come in. I've heard you were witnesses to the attack on the stained glass window.

GLADYS

Well, I didn't see it exactly. I heard it, but I was concentrating on what I was doing in the church.

ELIJAH

Praying?

GLADYS

No, scoring weed! Pagan Ginger legally sells weed on the side.

PAGAN GINGER

I'm a homegrower.

HONEY

Pagan Ginger, why aren't we friends. I feel like we'd get along.

PAGAN GINGER

No, I'm genuinely alternative. You're a wannabe.

HONEY

Well if you think that, then I think that.

HONEY'S MOM

Oh Honey, that's what makes you a wannabe! You shouldn't agree with her just because she's cool.

HONEY

But mom she is cool.

PAGAN GINGER

You're mom's right. And your mom is also pretty cool.

HONEY'S MOM

I am?? Well shucks, thanks for the compliment.

PASTOR

So Pagan Ginger was selling WEED in our CHURCH?

PAGAN GINGER

Pastor, no judgement. Also weed is like an herb.

ELIJAH

Pagan Ginger, rosemary is a herb. Weed is a drug.

CHET

Since when can a herb not be a drug? You eat a lot of those heroin-filled poppyseed bagels Elijah.

ELIJAH

I limit myself to one poppyseed bagel a week!

AGNES
For the record--

LIV
There's no official record here Agnes.

AGNES
FOR THE RECORD, I think Liv was rude
to interrupt me.

LIV
(sighs)
Just tell us what you saw.

AGNES
We heard the sound but I had to finish
paying Pagan Ginger.

PAGAN GINGER
Agnes was paying me in loose change.

GLADYS
I told Agnes to bring hard cash, but
she wanted to clear out her change
drawer.

AGNES
Pennies are still money!

GLADYS
So we went over to the window and we
saw this!

PASTOR
What did you just pull out of your
pocket?

GLADYS
It's a GRENADE!

fx; room gasps

ELIJAH
A *grenadeeeeeee??*

MARCY
Elijah, that was pitchy. It should
have been a *greandeeeee*.

AGNES
Relax, it's not a real grenade. It's a

toy grenade.

LIV

That's what destroyed the window then!
Someone accidentally tossed a grenade
through the window.

AGNES

Can you LET ME finish!?

LIV

But you had finished.

AGNES

I took a pause.

LIV

Well are you done now?

AGNES

I'm done with your attitude that's for
sure.

PASTOR

GIRLS, get it together. Whose grenade
is that?

AXL

It's not my grenade. My grenade is a
bit smaller and dark green. This
grenade is fake and brown colored.

AXL'S DAD

You have a greande?

AXL

Relax dad, it's just a grenade.

LIV

The grenade had to have been tossed
through the window by someone standing
outside the church!

GLADYS

Well no shit, there was glass
everywhere. I haven't seen that much
glass since I worked at the glass
factory when I was a kid.

AGNES

(stage whsiper)

Too bad you're not one of the kids who died in those factories.

ELIJAH

I saw Chet and Axl moments after the crash...so that means it can't be them.

fx; room muttering, 'wow, I guess the troublesome teens are innocent', chet and axl saying ' i told you we didn't do this'

PASTOR

Well we were about to convict innocent people.

ELIJAH

It goes to show you sometimes the troublesome teens aren't the troublesome ones after all.

CHET

Well now that we've been crucified, can we all go home now?

HONEY

But we didn't resolve Matilda and Samantha's dress...

SAMANTHA

I realized that maybe we should both wear the dress.

MATILDA

Really? Why?

SAMANTHA

Because you're one of my best friends. And it's funny we picked the same dress. So as friends, we're going to the dance together with the same dress. It's honestly perfect.

fx; room 'awh'

SAMANTHA

Besides we all know I'm going to look good in it.
